Eskleigh offers a statewide service with centres located in the North, South and North-West.

Eskleigh operates a 42 bed supported accommodation facility located at Perth in Tasmania's north, along with contemporary Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) properties in Longford, Kings Meadows, Montrose and Mornington, where people requiring support live as part of a group home arrangement.

Eskleigh also boasts a premier statewide support network, offering Community Access, In-Home Support, Supported Independent Living and Short-term Accommodation and Support Coordination services, offering support and respite in the home and within the community.

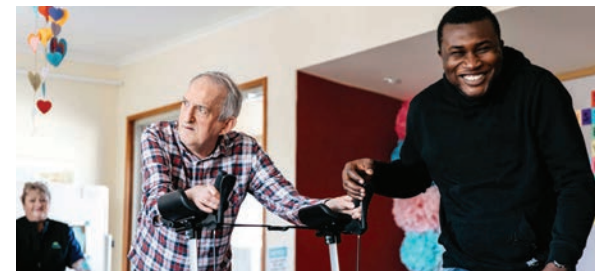

All services are supported by Eskleigh's cloud-based care portal, FlowPoint which gives you and your support network real-time access to all aspects of your support plan.

You can access and update details around funding, review calendars and appointments, communicate with your support workers, access important forms and keep track of your goals, and much more.

FlowPoint offers transparency, convenience and choice, whilst keeping you and your support network fully informed around all aspects of your care.

The type of activities you get involved in are up to you and can be undertaken either as part of a group or individually, weekdays, weekends and evenings.*

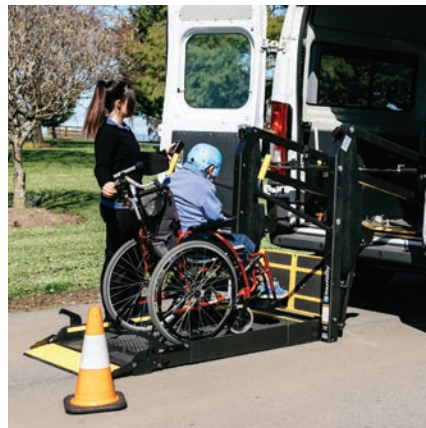
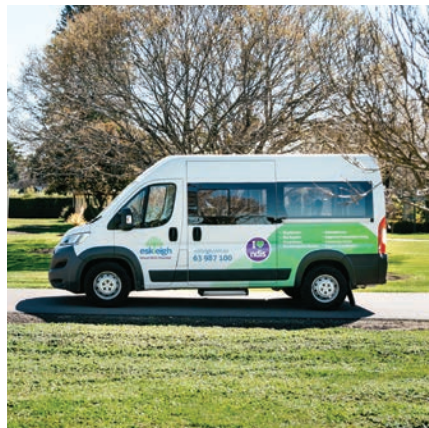
Your coordinator can help develop a Community Access Plan that is aligned with your personal goals and funding.

- ✓ Eskleigh offers an extensive Day Activity Program where participants can choose from over 20 activities conducted from our fully resourced centre located at Perth in northern Tasmania.
- ✓ Activities are available statewide from our centres in the north and south of the state or on a one-on-one basis from your home.
- ✓ Eskleigh operates a fleet of accessible vehicles, and offer a pick-up and drop-off service ensuring you get to where you need to be safely and conveniently.

Community Nursing

Registered nurses providing medical care when and where you need it for NDIS and Private participants.

Eskleigh's community nursing support aims to assist people living with a disability to maintain their independence through high quality nursing care in the privacy and comfort of their own home.

The type of medical support can be tailored to your specific needs and all services are delivered by our fully registered and qualified nursing staff who work in conjunction with your broader medical support team, including doctors and specialists.

The types of treatments delivered will be determined by your specific medical needs, however many of our clients choose our Community Nursing services for common treatments, such as:

- Health Assessments
- Medication Management and Support (Include Support to administer medications)
- Wound Care and Support
- Catheter management

Your Allied Health Team will assist with your assessment for SDA to ensure accommodation meets your needs and your application complies with your chosen method of funding.

Eskleigh operates SDA properties statewide and has plans in place to develop more in the near future including the recently announced development located in Prospect Vale.

Close to Prospect Vale Marketplace, our SDA property will feature easy access to shops, transport and community whilst offering the latest in assistive technologies.

Integrated with our supported independent living and community access services, residents will have the freedom they want with the support they need.

Short-Term Accommodation

Short-term accommodation for respite and care.

Sometimes you may require a short-term accommodation option for respite, when your usual caring supports aren't available or when you need to be away from your usual accommodation to participate in new activities such as a holiday.

Short-term Accommodation is designed to give you and your informal supports a well-earned break, change of scenery and routine.

Eskleigh can provide a range of short-term accommodation options for up to 14 days at a time in both shared and private accommodation.

Participants can choose from Esk Banks, a purpose-built facility located at Eskleigh's Perth head quarters or we can assist in arranging short-term stays at suitable accommodation right across the state.

Accommodation can be offered in conjunction with Eskleigh's extensive range of services and supports, including its Community Access Program and therefore

suitable for participants with needs for a wide range of supports.

All services are provided by our qualified Support Workers and Nurses who offer friendly and professional support and have the necessary skills to ensure you remain safe, connected and happy during your stay.

Your STA plan will include meals, accommodation, social activities, administration of medication, personal care and specialised around the clock support staff.

Supported Independent Living

Providing the support services you need to live as independently as possible.

Supported Independent Living services are offered usually as part of a shared living arrangement in one of Eskleigh's Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) houses and generally for people who require 24/7 support.

Eskleigh can provide a range of services to support you with daily living tasks, with a focus on enabling you to live as independently as possible.

Your Support Coordinator can help develop a Supported Independent Living Plan that is aligned with your personal goals and funding.

Many of our participants request support for daily living tasks such as attending appointments, household tasks such as preparation of meals and cleaning, as well as personal care, medical support and support with behavioral and social skills.

All services are provided by our qualified Support Workers and Nurses who offer friendly and professional support and have the necessary skills to ensure you remain safe, connected and happy as part of a Supported Independent Living community.

We will help you develop connections in the community, both formal and informal to help you identify and implement the most suitable services available to you.

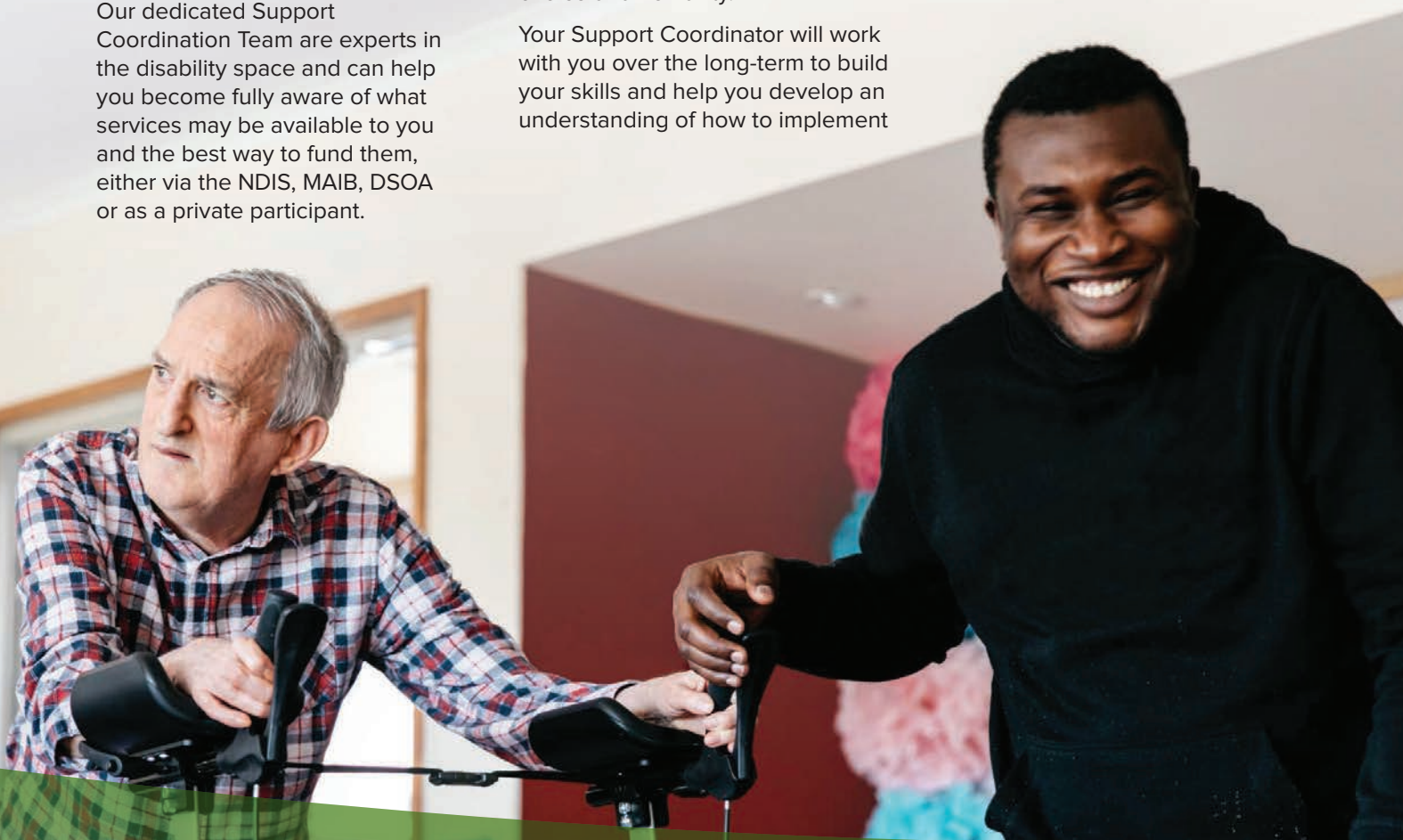

Funding methods to suit your situation

Eskleigh offers a range of specialist disability support services for people of all ages and abilities.

Our services can be accessed through the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS), the Motor Accidents Insurance Board (MAIB), Disability Support for Older Australians Program (DSOA) or as a private client.

National Disability Insurance Scheme

The National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) provides support to Australians with disabilities, their families and carers.

Eskleigh is a registered NDIS provider and can assist you in developing and implementing your NDIS plan.

Depending upon your individual situation and level of funding, all of Eskleigh's services can be accessed via the NDIS.

Eskleigh charges at the price limit, inline with the NDIS Support Catalogue.



Disability Support for Older Australians Program

The Disability Support for Older Australians Program (DSOA) provides support for vulnerable older Australian's aged 65 years and over (50 years and over for Indigenous people) with a disability who are not eligible for the NDIS.

The Disability Support for Older Australians (DSOA) Program is the replacement program to the Commonwealth Continuity of Support (CoS) Programme.



Motor Accidents Insurance Board

The Motor Accidents Insurance Board (MAIB) provides insurance cover for those who are injured in a motor accident. Funding for this compensation is provided by Tasmanian motorists through the payment of compulsory premiums on registered motor vehicles. MAIB pays for a range of treatment and support services for eligible people who have been injured regardless of fault.

Eskleigh is a preferred provider to the MAIB and can assist with a range of medical, rehabilitation, travel and in-home support services.



Private Patient

If the NDIS, MAIB or DSOA do not apply to your personal situation, you can still access any of Eskleigh's services as a private patient.

Support can be offered as a one-off short-term arrangement or provided over the longer-term depending upon your needs.

Eskleigh can work with you to help determine the type of support required and implement a suitable payment plan.
